A piece of plastic smaller than a beer mat will soon be saving fuel worth hundreds of thousands of pounds a year.

The Airtabs are fitted together on the side of cabs to deflect air away from the vehicle.

Results so far have shown a near 2% saving on fuel, and final testing is under way to compare performance between vehicles with Airtabs and those without. Road and track trials have proved the American device also

increases stability for drivers and their loads.

John Ward, Head of Vehicle Maintenance Unit, said Morrisons was leading the way in bringing the Airtabs to Britain's roads: "They are so cheap and work so well. The costs of applying them are minimal and the pay back is less than three months.

"I don't know of anybody else who has got them."

Drivers across the fleet can

expect to see Airtabs fixed to their vehicles in coming weeks.

Present laws prevent Airtabs being attached to trailers as they would push the vehicle beyond width restrictions, but the company will be pressing the Government to change the law.

Each wishbone-shaped Airtab creates two tight swirls of air that combine to reduce the suction and drag at the rear of vehicles travelling at speeds above 35mph
